## From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

**REMEMBER THAT SEPTEMBER IS THE MONTH OF OUR LADY OF SORROWS!**

### GERMANFEST!

That's all I have to say! You know what it is, how much fun it is, and how there's something for all. It's a no-brainer: be there! (Saturday, Sept. 24)

### CALLING ALL PILGRIMS! (second part)

Last week in this space I mentioned that I'm thinking about leading another pilgrimage to the places where our Church began and the faith first thrived, namely, the Apostolic See of Rome. The last time we went over on pilgrimage (2017), we were on a kind of whirlwind tour and really didn't get a good chance to soak in all that Mother Rome has to offer. This time, I hope to spend the 11 days or so of pilgrimage at a much more leisurely pace, spending most of the time in Rome, while also visiting artistic sites like Florence, and historical sites like Pompeii. The introductory meeting will take place on Monday, Sept. 12, at 7:00PM in the lunchroom. Since nothing has yet been determined, I hope to determine the following at this meeting: 1) whether there's enough interest to even make the trip, 2) what kind of sites people want to see, 3) what time of year people want to go, and 4) how long we expect the pilgrimage to last. No commitments will be made at the meeting. If you are interested but can't make the meeting, let me know. What makes this a pilgrimage, instead of a vacation, is that we will focus on those places where the Catholic faith was first established and still abides. I have always found such pilgrimages most edifying, and, on top of all that, you simply cannot get a bad meal in Italy!

### THE RETURN OF CATECHISM CLASS

After taking the whole summer off, we are hard-charging again back into that depository of Catholic teaching and belief, the Catechism of the Catholic Church. Our separated brethren rely solely on Scripture; not bad, but incomplete. The fullness of all the apostolic tradition is to be found in the catechism created by the Church that Jesus founded, and that He endowed with His own Authority. We meet on the first and third Tuesdays of each month in the Parish Meeting Room (accessible through the choir area of church) after the Tuesday night Devotions. While our main focus is the Catechism, we entertain all questions, disputes, controversies, etc., and, in the process, somehow manage to have a wonderful time! It kicks off this Tuesday, Sept. 6. (We will try to live-stream it, but we've had a lot of technical problems with that in the past.)

All are welcome to our come on our mini-pilgrimage to Cottleville, as we once again accept Dr. & Mrs. Piper's invitation to have Mass with them in beautiful chapel connected to their home. We'll have dinner afterwards again at Bemo's, where they'll set up a buffet of their signature dishes for \$25. Everyone is welcome, so spread the word!
