## *From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:*

**REMEMBER THAT FEBRUARY IS THE MONTH OF THE HOLY FAMILY!**

### **ALL THINGS NEW**

The program for the re-structuring of the Archdiocese of St. Louis is being called “All Things New” and is a once-in-a-lifetime thing. But the real time for renewal, which occurs annually, is fast upon us. I speak, of course, of the holy season of Lent. It starts March 2. Renewal is consistent with life itself. Your body, even as you sit there reading this, is renewing itself. It has to. The minute it stops is the minute you die. As goes the life of your body, so too the life of your soul. There will be enormous opportunities to renew your spiritual growth, with traditional devotions that are both year-round (like daily Mass and Eucharistic Adoration) and peculiar to the season (like Stations of the Cross, our Speaker Series, and your own personal acts of mortification and self-denial), and, most of all, special times to go to Confession; every legitimate attempt at spiritual renewal includes that.

### **MARDI GRAS/CHILI GRAS**

Before you embrace the discipline of Lent, you need to brace yourself for its rigors in advance. I recommend the Men’s Club Great Chili Cook-Off! It will be a first for us, and we’re looking for contestants who are willing to brandish their culinary competence, as well as consumers who are looking for some great carniferous victuals before the meatless days draw nigh. In any case, it should be a whole lot of fun! Tell your neighbors! (On Mardi Gras, of course, Tuesday, March 1, in the gym.)

### **IN HONOR OF ST. CASIMIR, THE POLISH PRINCE**

And don’t forget Polish Food Night on Saturday, March 5, right after the 5:00PM Mass! You know how good it is...tell your neighbors about it, too!

As one of our parishioners pointed out last Sunday, after the chili and polish food, we probably need to schedule this, too! (We’ll just leave it to your own genius to figure this one out!)

### **QUIZ-A-CATHOLIC**

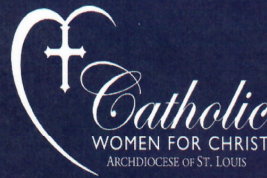

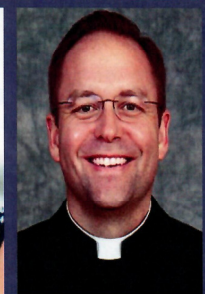
