REMEMBER THAT APRIL IS THE MONTH OF THE HOLY SPIRIT AND THE HOLY EUCHARIST!

DISCIPLE-MAKER-INDEX

Last week I posted here the website of the “Disciple-Maker-Index. Well, here it is again: all-thingsnew.archstl.org/Ways-to-engage/Disciple-Maker-index). Make sure you make your voice heard! (There are hard copies in the vestibule of church for the less-tech-savvy among us; mail it to the Archdiocese or drop it off at the parish offices.) All of this is due by Monday, April 4th.

PASSIONTIDE

The holy season of Lent shifts into overdrive, starting today, as we enter the singular season of *Passiontide*. During Lent’s last two weeks, we focus ever more directly on the sufferings of Christ, which were necessitated by our sins. It’s a uniquely somber season, and so we express that melancholy by the veiling of the icons and statues in our church, creating an ambiance of grief and gloom. Of course, it all ends with the sunburst of glory at the Resurrection, but I’m getting ahead of myself. The radiance and splendor come later; now, it’s time to be sad. Let us lament our sins and mourn Him Who paid the price of them.

There will be special Confession times this week (on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday); check the “Upcoming Events” at the bottom of this column for the days and times.

LOOKING AHEAD TO HOLY WEEK

Start planning now for Holy Week. There will be more special times for Confession (Monday, after the 8:00AM Mass/Tuesday at 1:00PM/Wednesday After 8:00AM Mass AND at 6:00PM). Then we have the great events of the Paschal Triduum, which change our usual schedule of Masses and services. **MAUNDY THURSDAY:** Morning Prayer at 8:00AM, Mass of the Lord’s Supper at 7:30PM, followed by the adoration of the Blessed Sacrament until midnight. **GOOD FRIDAY:** Morning prayer at 8:00AM, Stations of the Cross at 12:00noon, and the Good Friday service at 7:30PM. **HOLY SATURDAY:** Morning prayer at 8:00AM, Paschal Vigil at 7:30PM. (The schedule for Easter Sunday is the usual parish Sunday schedule.)

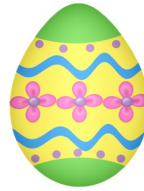

Please join us Sunday, April 10th, at 2:00 PM in the lunchroom for the showing of the movie *The Passion of the Christ*, the 2004 American epic biblical drama film directed by Mel Gibson and starring Jim Caviezel as Jesus Christ.
