## *From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:*

**REMEMBER THAT MAY IS THE MONTH OF MARY AND JUNE IS THE MONTH OF THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS!**

**“...TO CARE FOR HIM WHO SHALL HAVE BORNE THE BATTLE, AND FOR HIS WIDOW...”**

These words, gleaned from President Lincoln’s Second Inaugural Address, form the essence of the motto of our national Veterans’ Administration, and are the foundational premise for our annual observance of Memorial Day. We will, indeed, observe this great national holiday and, with every asset at our disposal, pray for our dead warriors who, again in the words of President Lincoln, rendered “the last full measure of devotion”, in the defense of our nation and the protection of us all. Mass will be celebrated, as is our custom, on Monday, May 30, at 9:00AM.

### **ROE v. WADE (THE MOVIE)**

There will be a special encore presentation of this movie about the main issue that, fifty years later, still roils the country, namely, the forced legalization of abortion on all fifty states by judicial mandate. It is ever more topical now, with the recent fulminations about the possible overturn of this landmark ruling. 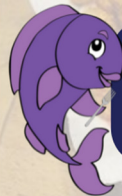
