## From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

**REMEMBER THAT JULY IS THE MONTH OF THE MOST PRECIOUS BLOOD OF JESUS!**

### SIXTY YEARS ON NORTH HIGHWAY 67

By all accounts, one's 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary is considered the "Diamond Jubilee". Our parish is about to celebrate its diamond anniversary in grand fashion on Monday, July 18. Why that day? Well, mostly because that is the actual date for the founding of our parish (inasmuch as that was the date attached to the letter that Cardinal Ritter sent to Fr. Kersgieter officially establishing the parish and naming him its first pastor). It's also a Monday, which means that the people that we most want to attend (namely priests who served here years ago, old parishioners who have moved away, and, at the very top of the list, our active parishioners) will have fewer scheduling conflicts. We do hope that you all can come; it should be a diamond-studded blast!

### GOD THE FATHER MASS

For the past several years, our parish has hosted the annual Mass to honor God the Father and, by extension, the virtues connected with paternity. It's not a feast recognized officially by the Church (but neither was *Corpus Christi* right away) and came about from a private revelation (like *Corpus Christi*) to Mother Eugenia Ravasio and there isn't even a liturgy connected with it (ibid., *Corpus Christi*). So, once again, on Sunday, August 7, we'll actually be celebrating the liturgy of the 19<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time. Nonetheless, God the Father will be given prominence in a distinctive way, and the nobility of paternity, as distinctly consistent with God's design of creation, will be celebrated. Everyone is welcome!

### FEAST OF THE TRANSFIGURATION

Two weeks after our 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary, we will host our annual observance of the great events of 2005 when St. Christopher's parish and Transfiguration (the Western half, anyway) were merged into our parish. We have always marked this moment of our history in the sweetest way possible: by an ice cream social after the 5:00PM Mass on the Saturday closest to the feast of the Transfiguration. That feast day is August 6, and this year, it actually does fall on a Saturday, so that's when it will be. Whether you're an old Transfiguration person (like me) or not, please come and join with us this great expression of our parochial solidarity.

### HOLY INFANT OF PRAGUE (part II)

Last week I explained what happened to our statue of the Holy Infant of Prague and, in record time, He has returned! Yes, He's back and sporting a new set of duds that, while not exactly high society, are quite fitting in more ways than one. Our thanks to those anonymous good souls who took care of him and re-presented Him to us in His present dignified state.
