### **REMEMBER THAT MAY IS THE MONTH OF OUR LADY!**

#### **ALL THINGS NEW**

The Archdiocese's unprecedented and radical re-organization plan will be revealed next Sunday. Its implementation will be gradual, and we won't be seeing any real changes for a while. All in all, we hope for the best.

#### **MAY CROWNING**

The thought struck me the other day that, since the closing of our school a few years ago, we haven't had a decent May Crowning (or any other kind, now that I think of it), and that's just plain wrong. Mary, the Mother of God, needs to be honored, as Christ Himself intended. And so, mark your calendars: Wednesday, May 31, the last day of the month of Mary and the feast of her Visitation, at 7:00PM in church, we will crown the Blessed Mother! It will be the traditional devotion, with the rosary, Marian hymns, processions, and Benediction. It should be wonderful!

#### **MASS AT PIPERS' CHAPEL (please note the date change)**

We're having Mass at the Piper Family Chapel on *Thursday, June 8*. #### **QUIZ-A-CATHOLIC**
