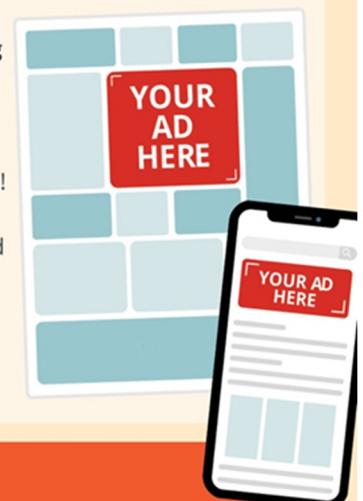

ALL THINGS NEW

PASTOR OUT OF TOWN - MISSIONARY VISITING US

I am going to head east again to do some sponging off my relatives. I will leave this Wednesday and be back the following Wednesday (the 28th). We will have Mass here every day when I'm gone, and the weekend Masses will be covered by the missionary priest assigned to us for this year. He is Fr. Claudius Mganga from the African diocese of Mwanza. Please welcome him and be generous in your response to his appeal.

ORDINARY TIME

It's Ordinary Time again and we're now back to the wearing of the green. We will see green every Sunday (and most weekdays) until Advent. (It's a good thing that green, of all the colors, is the most soothing to the eye - no wonder God made the grass and trees green!)

NO CATECHISM THIS TUESDAY

Due to important meetings about to take place, the Catechism Class for this Tuesday is cancelled. It will resume July 11 (the first Tuesday is the 4th!).
