The big announcement about the fate of all the parishes and clergy of the Archdiocese of St. Louis took place last week and I'm sure that, by now, you know all about it. Unhappily, because of the logistics involving the national holiday and the timing of the announcement, I cannot comment on it here. Both last weeks and this week's bulletins had to go to press before the announcement, so I couldn't possibly comment on it. I will say what needs to be said in next week's bulletin.

MASS AT PIPERS' CHAPEL (please note the date change)

I will be offering Mass at the home of Dr. Piper and his wife, Judy, in their beautiful chapel. They have graciously made it available to us, and all are welcome. Either meet here at St. Angela at 4:30 this Thursday or meet us at their residence in Cottleville at 5:30 (ask for directions at our parish office). If you can join us, sign up on the sheet in the lunchroom by Wednesday, so that we can have an accurate count on the number joining us for dinner after.

CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION

Pencil it in! The great Florissant Corpus Christi Procession, steeped in history and hallowed by tradition, will take place again on the streets of Old Town Florissant next Sunday evening, June 11, at 7:00. It will begin at Sacred Heart church and work its way through the ancient streets of the village to the oldest church in our Archdiocese, the old St. Ferdinand shrine (Refreshments to follow). A very special invitation is extended to all our First Communicants, that they will be given pride of place in the procession, attired in their First Communion apparel.

VOCATIONS

It's time to get serious about vocations! Toward that end, I am trying to organize our parish as a powerhouse of prayer for vocations to the priesthood and religious life. 7. Jesus contrasts the wisdom of being prepared with the foolishness of being unprepared.
8. Jesus chastises the wealthy for their being oblivious to the poor who live around them.
9. Jesus describes Himself as One who loves His sheep so much that He will die for them.
10. Jesus extols the virtue of vigilance in waiting for the Second Coming.
