Pondering With Deacon George:

God With Us Draws Near

This Fourth Sunday of Advent brings us very close to Christmas. The readings the Church gives us this weekend helps us focus on who Jesus is and why He came. We hear the name Emmanuel, which means “God is with us.” This is the message we hold onto as we get ready to celebrate His birth not only in history but in our hearts and every facet of our lives.

Each reading gives us something to think about. Isaiah speaks of a sign—a child born to a virgin. Paul reminds the early Christians that Jesus was promised long ago. The psalm talks about who can come into God’s presence. And in the Gospel, Joseph listens to God and chooses to stay with Mary.

These are not just stories from the past. As scripture has the power to do, the Word of God we are given today speaks to us in the here and now. Like Joseph, we are asked to trust. We are called to be open to where the Lord may lead and have the courage to say “yes” even when we may not understand what God is asking. Like Paul, we are called to share the good news. We cannot keep the great things God has done for us to ourselves. And like the people in Isaiah’s time, we are told that God will not leave us alone. We can be assured always that God walks with us on our journey of life.

As Christmas draws near, we are invited to quiet our hearts and wait with hope and joy, knowing that God is coming to be with us.

The Respect Life Committee of St. Angela asks that while you are shopping for the holidays online or in-store that you consider purchasing one or more of any basic item required for a baby's care like diapers, wet wipes, bottles, etc. Here are specific suggestions most needed now at Birthright:

- * Diapers: preemie, newborn, size 1, and size 4
- * long sleeve onesies newborn to 1yr (Fall/Winter)
- * fleece pajamas: newborn -1yr (Fall/Winter)
- * baby bottles
- * Winter clothing: newborn - 1 yr (We are really low on winter clothing)
- * bibs
- * washcloths

They could also use gift cards for groceries or to Target or Walmart so the mothers can purchase a car seat, formula, or put toward a crib.

There will be a container in the church vestibule during the month of January to put the items you purchase. With your help and prayers, we can support the Birthright counselors and the Moms and Dads with resources to enable them to choose life for their children. 
