When the magi had departed, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream and said, “Rise, take the child and his mother, flee to Egypt, and stay there until I tell you. Herod is going to search for the child to destroy him.”

Matthew 2:13

Most Blessed Christmas to all. On this first Sunday after Christmas Day, we honor the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph. This celebration reminds us that Jesus lived in a real family. He had a mother and a father who cared for Him and protected Him. Mary and Joseph did not have easy lives, but they trusted God and followed His plan. Their home was simple, but it was full of love.

In our Gospel, we see that the Holy Family — Joseph, Mary, and Jesus — went through a lot of change. They had to pack up and leave everything behind because Jesus was in danger. But even though everything around them kept changing, the Holy Family stayed strong together. Joseph listened to God in his dreams. He didn't ignore what God told him. He acted quickly and protected his family. Mary supported Joseph and went with him wherever God led. She trusted God, even when the future was unclear. And Jesus, though still a small child, was always at the center of their love and care.

This story teaches us something very important. A holy family is not a family that has everything figured out. It's not a family that never struggles. A holy family is one that stays close to God and close to each other. It is a family that makes love the center, especially when things are hard. That's what made the Holy Family special — not an easy life, but a faithful life.

May we strive to make our homes — whether with our spouse, relatives, friends, or community — places where God's love is visible, peace is nurtured, and hope is shared,

BIRTHRIGHT COLLECTION DRIVE

Every year in January St. Angela Merici parish has a collection for the Birthright organization located in St. Charles. Birthright offers support to pregnant women providing them the means to choose life for their unborn children.

The Respect Life Committee of St. Angela asks that while you are shopping for the holidays online or in-store that you consider purchasing one or more of any basic item required for a baby's care like diapers, wet wipes, bottles, etc. Here are specific suggestions most needed now at Birthright:

- * Diapers: preemie, newborn, size 1, and size 4
- * long sleeve onesies newborn to 1yr (Fall/Winter)
- * fleece pajamas: newborn - 1yr (Fall/Winter)
- * baby bottles
- * Winter clothing: newborn - 1 yr (We are really low on winter clothing)
- * bibs
- * washcloths

They could also use gift cards for groceries or to Target or Walmart so the mothers can purchase a car seat, formula, or put toward a crib.

There will be a container in the church vestibule during the month of January to put the items you purchase. With your help and prayers, we can support the Birthright counselors and the Moms and Dads with resources to enable them to choose life for their children.
