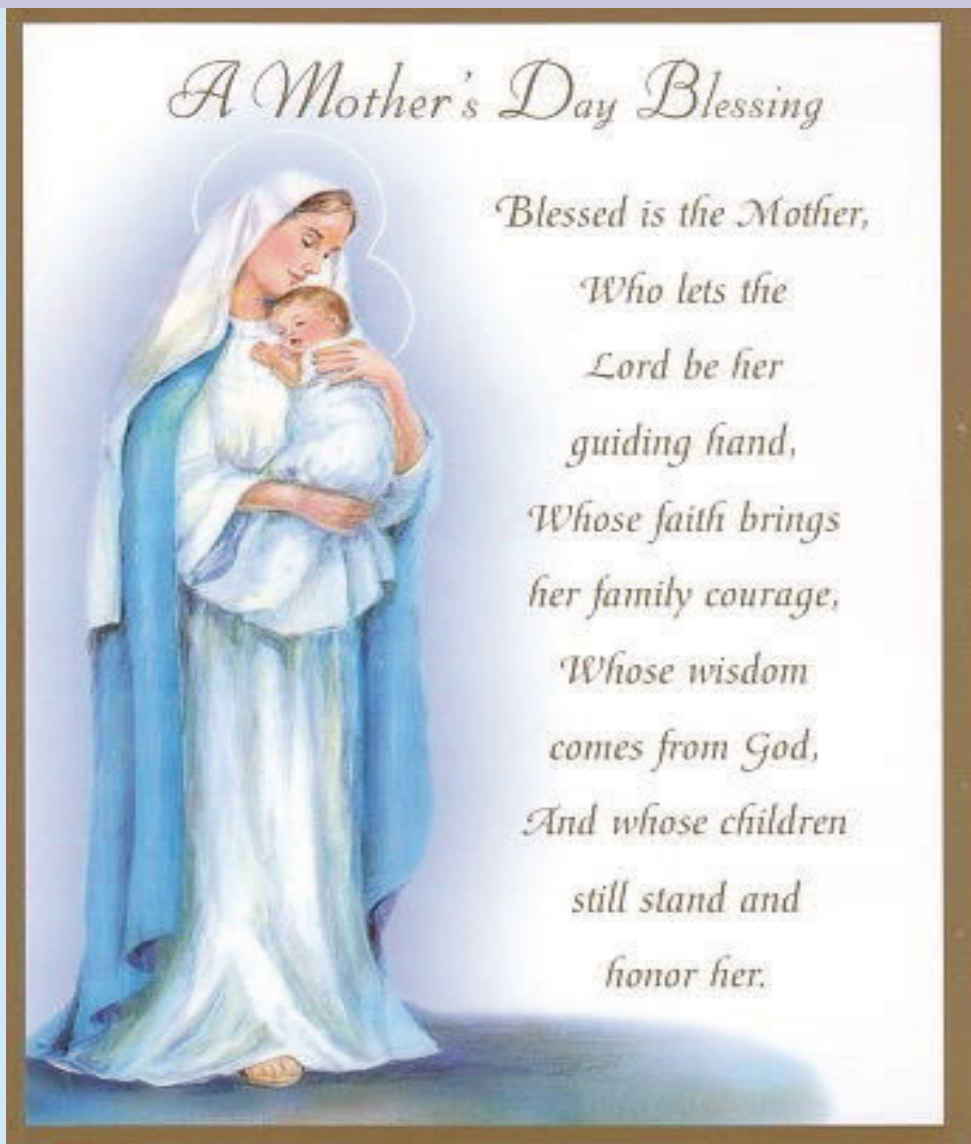

Pondering With Deacon George:

**Jesus said:
"My sheep hear my voice;
I know them, and they follow me."
- John 10: 27**

The Fourth Sunday of Easter each year is traditionally called Good Shepherd Sunday; a day in which the liturgy focuses on Jesus, the Good Shepherd and His care and protection for us. When Jesus taught, he constantly used images that the people of his day would understand; a shepherd and sheep was one of such image. People of his day understood the role of the shepherd and the relationship between the shepherd and his sheep.

Although many people today are far less familiar with the metaphors of sheep and shepherd as the people Jesus spoke to did; the image of Jesus as the Good Shepherd and the community of followers as his sheep has endured over the centuries as a primary image in our faith tradition. Its power to describe the relationship between Jesus and his followers transcends direct experience with sheep. The image speaks to us about the protection, security, and care that shepherds represent for their sheep. Today's Gospel speaks powerfully about the familiarity and intimacy between Jesus and his disciples, expressed as recognizing and knowing another's voice. In a world full of business and distractions, it is easy miss the voice of Jesus in our lives. And yet, our Gospel this weekend reminds us that Jesus, the Good Shepherd, calls us to listen to his voice and follow where He leads.

By learning to listen to God, we can develop a deeper connection with Him and come to understand that God knows us intimately and always desires to guide us. When we hear His voice, we will be better prepared to respond in faith and follow him in our daily lives.

May we always follow the voice and guidance of Jesus,
