Pope Leo XIV A New Chapter in the Church

As Pope Leo XIV celebrates his Inauguration Mass on Sunday, May 18th, we as a Church celebrate with joy the formal beginning of the pontificate of Pope Leo XIV as the vicar of Christ on earth.

As an Augustinian friar and the first American-born Pope, Pope Leo has served the people of God across cultures and continents – from his roots in Chicago to the missions of Peru and more recently in the Vatican itself.
