Tondering With Deacon George:

"Come, have breakfast." - John 21: 12

I recently read a reflection on this Sunday's gospel which said "this is one of the best-smelling stories in all of the gospels". Although I have never thought of this gospel that way before, I realized how true that statement was. In today's gospel we have the apostles fishing on the Sea of Galilee and the fresh air along the seashore. Jesus is on the shore with charcoal burning, fresh bread and grilled fish. Then Jesus invites his disciples to have breakfast with Him. Like with the disciples, the risen Christ invites us also to encounter him in a very intimate meal through the Eucharist. The gospels are full of stories revolving around meals; and yet in each of them, the food is not the main focus of the story, but the encounter of Jesus and others. In each of them, Jesus used the opportunity of table fellowship to enter into an intimate communion with those he has gathered with to share in a meal.

Just as He did 2,000 years ago, Jesus calls each of us to table fellowship, an intimate encounter with Him every time we gather to celebrate the Eucharist. In this encounter Jesus draws us close to Himself, He feeds us with the Word of God and the Eucharist, our spiritual food, in order that we may be transformed to be his witness to others. May we, each time we are fed at the Eucharistic Table of the Lord come to a deeper realization that from this meal, we are called, not to just eat and drink but to go forth and share his Good News with those we encounter daily.

Lord Jesus, our Bread of Life,
you know our hunger and thirst.
Fill and nourish us
that we might find strength in you,
and carry your Good News to those we encounter.
We make this prayer in your Holy Name.
Amen!

May we always savor the meal the Lord invites us to and allow it to transform our lives,
