## *Pondering With Deacon George:*

**Jesus said to his disciples:  
“Thus it is written that the Christ would suffer  
and rise from the dead on the third day  
and that repentance, for the forgiveness of sins,  
would be preached in his name  
to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem.  
You are witnesses of these things.”**

Leonardo da Vinci had started to work on a large canvas in his studio. For a while he worked at it – choosing the subject, planning the perspective, sketching the outline, applying the colors, with his own extraordinary genius. Then suddenly he stopped working on it. Summoning one of his talented students, the master invited him to complete the work. The horrified student protested that he was both unworthy and unable to complete the great painting, which his master had begun. But da Vinci silenced him. “Will not what I have done inspire you to do your best?”

That is the message of the Ascension of the Lord. Although Jesus returned to the Father after his earthly mission, what he started is not finished. Before returning to heaven, he summoned his students, his disciples, to continue the work he had started. That mission has been passed on down through the centuries to us as well. Like de Vinci’s student, we can feel unworthy and unable to continue his work. And yet, Jesus did not just vanish from our sight, but continues to be present to us, guiding us, inspiring us to do our best.

As Jesus promised his apostles, he continues to be present in the Church, equipping us to continue his work by giving different gifts to different members of the Church. What gift has Jesus given to you to use for the Church? He surely has given you a gift to be used for the benefit of all of us here. We want to let the whole world see that the Church, that our parish, is the place where Jesus continues to be present after his ascension.

As we celebrate this great feast, we pray that the Church will more and more become what Jesus calls it to be and that all may come to know and find Jesus. He illustrated his message and he has left us to finish the picture. It’s up to us, inspired by his life, to finish our little part of his masterpiece.

May we always be aware of Jesus’ presence and action in our lives,
