

# **Pondering With Deacon George:**

No one can say, "Jesus is Lord," except by the Holy Spirit. There are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit; there are different forms of service but the same Lord."

### - 1 Corinthians 3:2 - 5

This weekend we celebrate Pentecost, the day in which we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit to the first disciples, to the early church: the same spirit that is at work in the church today.

After having witnessed the death of Jesus, the early disciples were very much afraid. Even though they had witnessed the many signs of Jesus' resurrection, his disciples were shaken to the core. Throughout the church's history, the Holy Spirit has guided many holy men and women, people of faith, of every age, of every back ground, to use their God given gifts to share Jesus.' message of love, joy and peace and thus build up Christ's body on earth

The Holy Spirit continues to guide us today, the young and old, the rich and poor, people of all walks of life. All of us have a role in building up the Kingdom of God. What gifts have God given you for the good of continuing Jesus' mission? Are you willing to use those gifts?
