

Fondering With Deacon George:

Go and do likewise"

Our Gospel this weekend is one so familiar to us that often it is easy to skim through and miss the lesson Jesus is trying to teach. Jesus uses the parable of the Good Samaritan to help us understand that being a "neighbor" is not just about proximity or friendship. It's about seeing others through God's eyes and responding with love through our actions.

In the parable, Jesus responds to a lawyer who asks, "Who is my neighbor?" with a story that challenges us to see everyone as our neighbor, especially those who are suffering or in need. The priest and Levite walked past the injured man, but the Samaritan chose compassion, even though Jews and Samaritans were enemies at the time. Jesus ends with a clear instruction: "Go and do likewise." This message is at the heart of what it means to live as a follower of Christ.

We are called to be the presence of Christ to others in our little part of the world. As St. Teresa of Avila famously wrote: "Christ has no body on earth but yours. Yours are the eyes with which he looks compassionately on this world. Yours are the feet with which he walks to do good. Yours are the hands, with which he blesses all the world".

So often we may think that others will respond to the needs of our neighbor. We may be like the priest or Levite and go along our way. But we can never assume someone else will step in. Jesus is asking us to be the one who chooses to act with kindness and mercy, just like the Good Samaritan.

This week we can look at those who cross our path and ask: "Where can I be the eyes, the feet, and the hands of Jesus for this person". Where can I bring the love and compassion of Jesus to someone who needs to encounter Christ in their lives. The Good Samaritan responded to the man along the road with love and compassion. As followers of Jesus, we are called to "Go and do likewise".

May we see others with eyes of Jesus and respond in love,


