Fondering With Deacon George:

Martha, Martha, you are anxious and worried about many things. There is need of only one thing. Mary has chosen the better part and it will not be taken from her. - Luke 10:41-42

It is not a surprise to anyone that we live in fast-paced world, and countless distractions can pull our attention in many directions. From the constant buzz of a 24 hour news cycle, social media, family and work responsibilities many demands can be placed on our time. That being said, it is important to realize that many of these distractions and demands aren't inherently bad; but they can take up so much space that there's little room left for what truly matters—our relationship with God.

Our Gospel passage this weekend is the story of Martha and Mary, two sisters who had to figure out how to balance work and time with Jesus. When Jesus visits their home, Martha immediately starts preparing everything to make Him feel welcome. She is cooking, cleaning, and making sure everything is perfect. Mary, on the other hand, chooses to sit at Jesus' feet and listen to Him teach.

This story helps us understand that even in today's busy world, making time for God is both possible and necessary. God doesn't ask us to give up all the things we enjoy or stop doing what's important in our daily lives. But He does ask us to put Him first. This doesn't mean we have to spend hours in prayer every day or give up all our activities. It's about finding balance and making small but intentional choices to prioritize our relationship with God.

In the middle of all we have to do, how do we put God first. We can start and end our day with just five minutes of prayer. We can read a short passage from Scripture and think about how it relates to our life. We can take a moment to thank God for our blessings and ask God to guide us through the day. Even small changes like these can make a big difference. Over time, they help us build a habit of turning to God, even when life gets busy. Remember, He understands what it's like to be human and experience daily challenges. He's always ready to help us, but we need to make space in our life to hear His voice. Then the work we do, flowing from our prayer and relationship with the Lord, can bear fruit.

May we put God first and everything else in our lives will fall into place,


