Pondering With Deacon George:

I tell you, ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks, receives; and the one who seeks, finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened.

- Luke 11:9-10

How do you pray? In our Gospel text this weekend (Luke 11:1-13) we encounter Jesus teaching His disciples how to pray and emphasizes persistence in prayer, assuring them that God will answer. Jesus highlights God's readiness to give the Holy Spirit to those who ask. In the Gospel, Jesus teaches his disciples and us, the Lord's Prayer. He also tells us to keep asking, seeking, and knocking. God is not far away. He wants to hear from us and give us good gifts.

When we come to God in prayer, there is three movements that take place: Asking, Trusting, and Receiving. So often in our prayer, we ask expecting to receive what we are asking for. We often forget the "Trusting" part of the equation. Sometimes we may feel like we are knocking and no one is answering. We ask, and what we ask for is not made available. We seek and do not find. That is where Trust comes in. Jesus does not promise us that our prayers will be answered the way we want or that our greatest desire will come true. He does say to ask, seek and knock. This is not a one time deal. We come back repeatedly to knock on the door. God is not going anywhere. It is up to us to keep turning to God. When we come to God in prayer, we can be assured that God hears us. Our God is not a God that is distant from us but a God who is always nearby. When we pray, we can trust that God is paying attention.

May we entrust ourselves to God, he will always give us what we truly need,

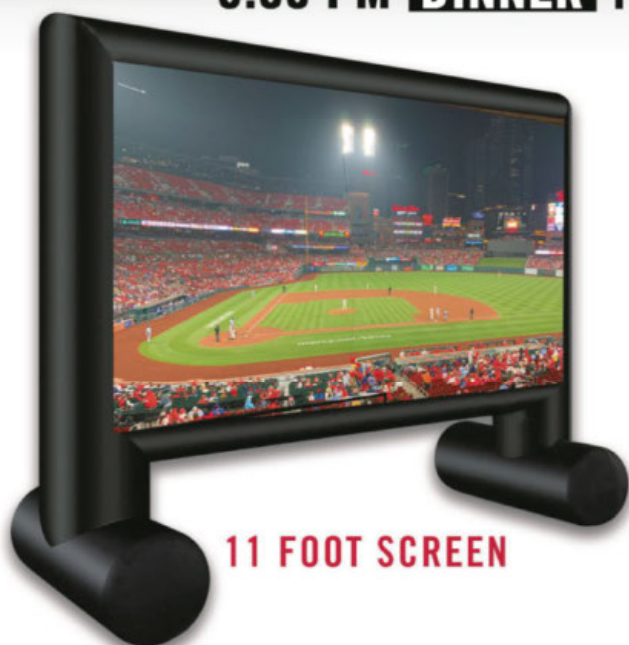
