

Stay Awake and Be Ready

The last few Sundays have in many ways been a guide in how to live as a follower of Jesus. Love our neighbor, focus on Jesus and do not be distracted by things of the world, preserve in pray, focus on what is truly important, attaining eternal life. Those can seem like easy and simple things to do, but are they? If we take a deep look, faith is not always easy to live or keep up with. With the busyness of life, faith can sometimes feel like just another thing on the to-do-list, and it's easy to put off. But in our Gospel this weekend, **Jesus calls us to be ready and stay faithful**. Active faith means making God part of our everyday life, not just something we think about on Sundays.

Having an active faith doesn't mean we have to be perfect. It means we try. It means making an effort to pray, even when we don't feel like it. It means choosing to be kind when it's easier to ignore someone. It means showing up to Mass and paying attention, even when there are others things we might like to do. It means asking questions when we don't understand something about our faith.


