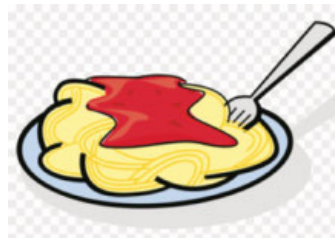
JUST FOR FUN
