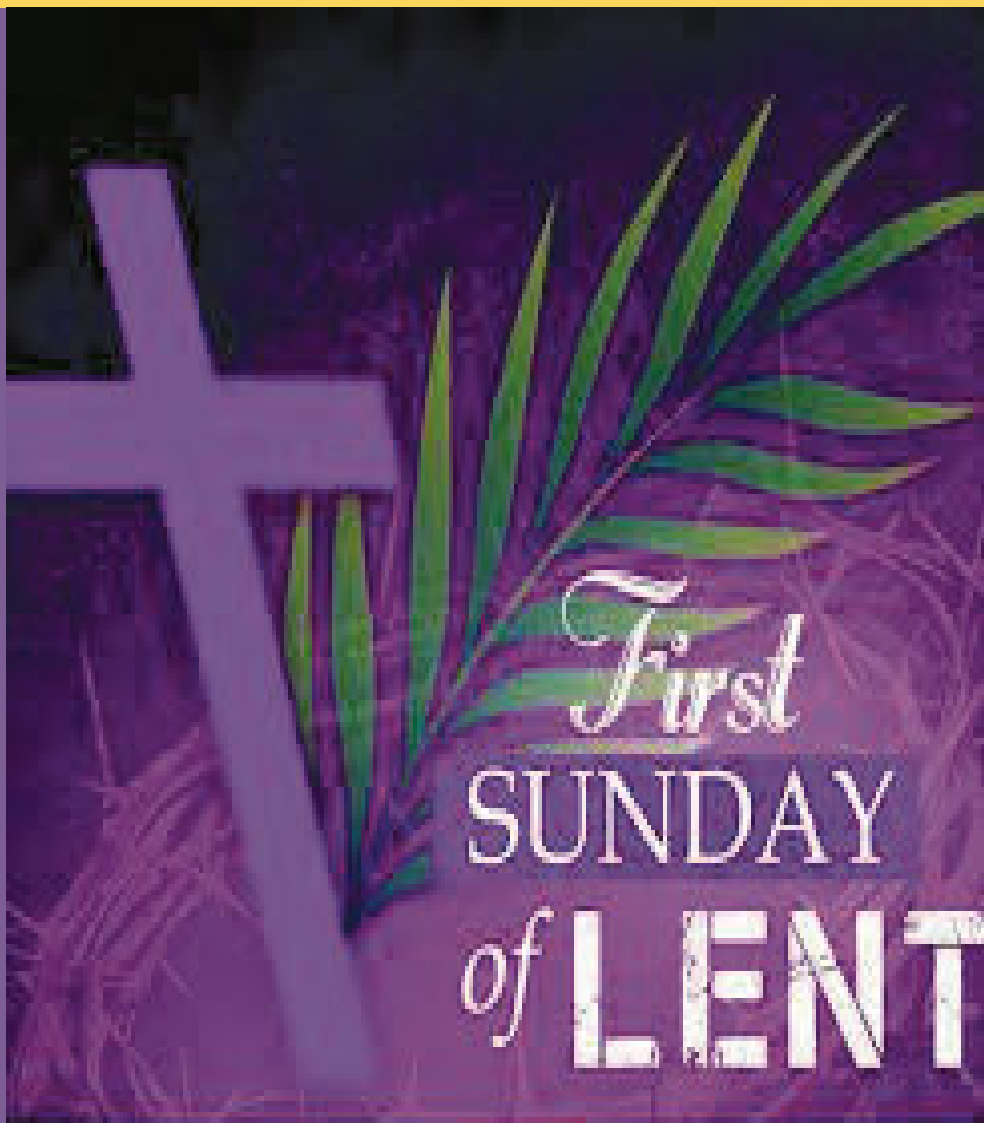

After Jesus was baptized, he was led to the desert by the Spirit to be tempted by the devil. Lent is our 40 Days in the desert to grow closer to our God and one another. During this time, we strip away many of the nonessential things of life in order to grow in our relationship with God through Prayer, Giving and Fasting.
