


## Pondering With Deacon George:

As he was walking by the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon who is called Peter, and his brother Andrew, casting a net into the sea; they were fishermen.  
He said to them,  
"Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men."  
Matthew 4: 18

In our gospel this weekend, Jesus, walking by the Sea of Galilee calls out to Simon and his brother Andrew and ask them to follow him and to become fishers of men. They dropped their nets and followed him.

Jesus has called out to Christians through the centuries to do the same, from Peter and Andrew to each of us. We too are called to be fishers of men. But in what ways are we fishers of men? Whether we spend our day typing in a cubicle, caring for little ones or serving our community, all have a responsibility to our fellow brothers and sisters. All of us should be concerned with evangelization, whether that means preaching to hundreds, reminding a four-year-old to say his or her prayers at night or showing someone in need that they are loved. It is easy for us to think that some people are called to be fishers of men and others are called to hide in the shadows, but that is not true. In the *Joy of the Gospel* Pope Francis wrote: **"In virtue of their baptism, all the members of the People of God have become missionary disciples (cf. Mt 28:19). All the baptized, whatever their position in the Church or their level of instruction in the faith, are agents of evangelization"** (#120).

In other words, sharing the Good News of Jesus is not just the work of priests and deacon, rather, we are all called to share the Good News, no matter how it looks in our individual life, in our little part of the world. Whether showing love, kindness and respect to others or serving others through acts of service, we bring the Good News to others.

May Jesus fill us with a desire to share His name and show us how we can be fisher of men in our daily lives,
