Pondering With Deacon George:

Blessed are . . .

Our Gospel this weekend centers on one of the most beloved and profound passages of the Gospel: The Beatitudes (Matthew 5:1-12). This portion of Scripture marks the beginning of Jesus' Sermon on the Mount, offering timeless wisdom and a radical vision for living as disciples in the world.

When Jesus sat down with his disciples, he proclaimed blessings not upon those who were strong or wealthy, but upon those who are poor in spirit, those who mourn, the meek, those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, the merciful, the pure in heart, the peacemakers, and those persecuted for righteousness' sake. These words turn the world's values upside down, inviting us to reconsider where true happiness and fulfillment are found.

In our daily life, it is easy to be swept up by the desire for success, recognition, or comfort. Yet, Jesus calls us to a deeper reality – one that recognizes God's presence in humility, compassion, and integrity. The Beatitudes do not glorify suffering for its own sake, but assure us that God is with those who struggle, encouraging us to bring comfort, justice, and peace to others.

The Beatitudes challenge us to see beyond appearances and popularity, and to recognize that God's blessing is found in the everyday acts of kindness, in standing up for what is right, and in showing mercy even when it is difficult. This path is not always easy, but it is one that brings true peace and joy – the kingdom of heaven begins to take root in us and around us.

Reflect on which Beatitude speaks most to our current situation. Where do we feel poor, meek, or in need of mercy? Are there places in our lives where we are called to be peacemakers or to stand up for justice?

Let us ask God for the grace to live more fully according to these blessings, trusting that the promise of the kingdom is for all who follow Christ's way, even in ordinary, daily life,

ANOINTING OF THE SICK DURING MASS

WEEKEND OF FEBRUARY 14-15



"Is any among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord; and the prayer of faith will save the sick man, and the Lord will raise him up; and if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven."

- James 5:14-15

Throughout his public ministry, Jesus healed the sick both physically and spiritually. The apostles continued this ministry and handed it on to their successors. For 2,000 years, the Church has continued Jesus' ministry of healing through the **Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick**.

At St. Angela Merici, we offer this sacrament monthly following Mass (on a rotating basis). Because of the communal nature of this Sacrament of Healing, we will also celebrate the **Anointing of the Sick**, during Mass, twice a year. The next communal celebration will be the weekend of **February 14-15 during all Masses**.

This Sacrament is a sacrament of healing and so is for anyone who has a chronic, serious illness, anyone preparing for surgery, or anyone suffering from the effects of advance age.

We invite all in the parish who could receive benefit and grace from this sacrament to join us on February 14-15 as we pray with and for each other, asking God's healing, comfort, and grace for all who receive the sacrament.
