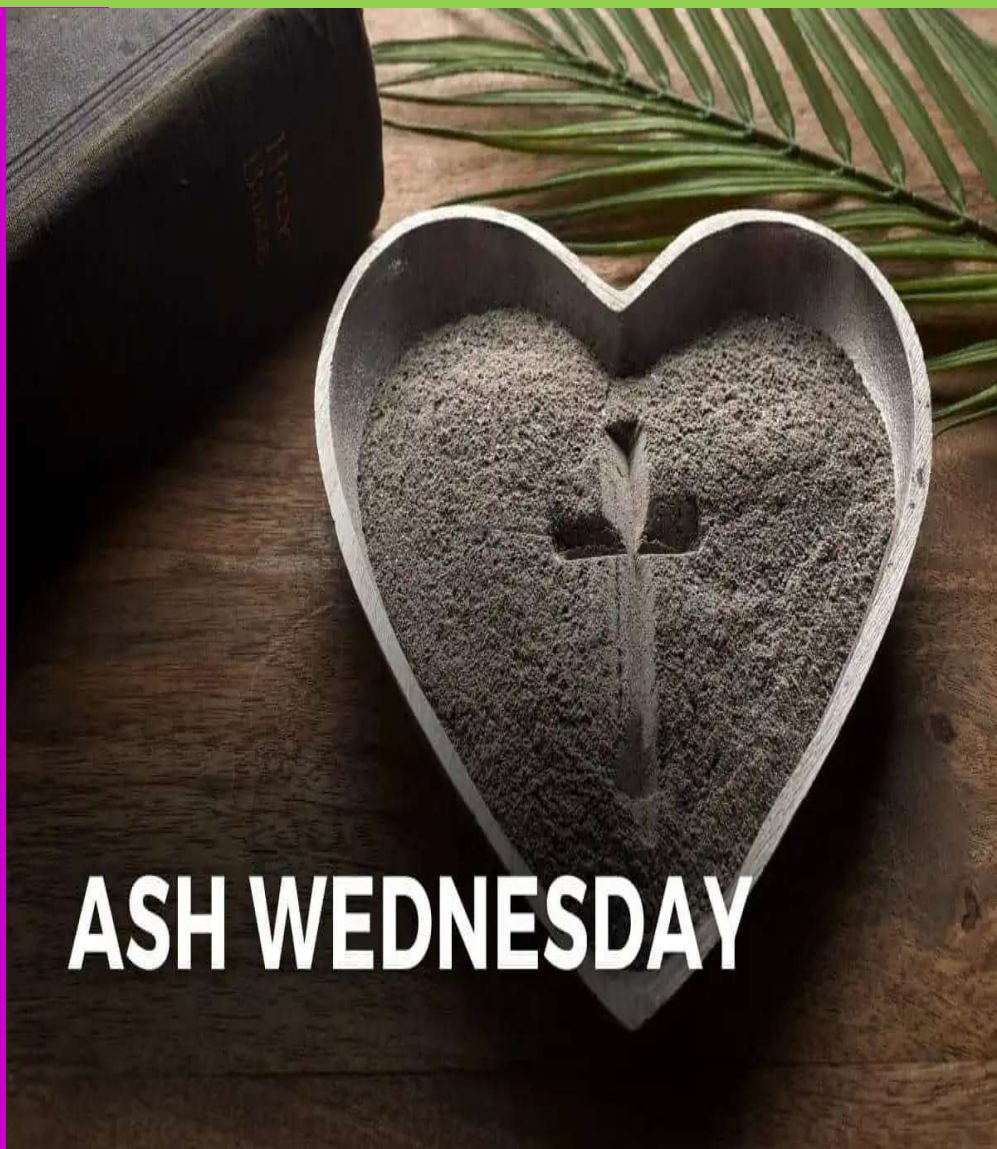

Pondering With Deacon George:

“Do not think that I have come to abolish the law or the prophets; I have come not to abolish but to fulfill.”

On this Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time, we are invited to dive deeper into the teachings of Jesus. Jesus continues His Sermon on the Mount, challenging His listeners – and all of us today – to move beyond the mere letter of the law and embrace its true spirit, which is rooted in love, mercy, and integrity.

Jesus begins by affirming the value of the law: “Do not think that I have come to abolish the law or the prophets; I have come not to abolish but to fulfill.” This statement underscores the continuity between the old covenant and the new. Yet, Jesus goes further, calling His followers to a deeper righteousness – not just external observance but inner transformation. He warns against anger, insults, and grudges. Rather He urges reconciliation, forgiveness, and purity of heart, reminding us that God sees not only our actions but the intentions behind them.

The readings challenge us to examine our own hearts. Are we content with simply following rules, or are we striving for genuine conversion and holiness? Our actions must reflect our inner values. Jesus calls us to cultivate a spirit of reconciliation – settling disputes promptly, avoiding resentment, and seeking peace with others; especially in our daily relationships, where misunderstandings and conflicts can arise. As we near the beginning of our annual Lenten Journey, a season of conversion, it is important for us to realize that we are a work in the making and spiritual growth is not a one-time event but a lifelong journey. Jesus’s radical teachings remind us that following Him requires ongoing self-examination and openness to His grace. He invites us to let go of anger, bitterness, and anything that divides us from God or our neighbors. As we approach the altar each Sunday, we are called to bring not just our offerings, but our hearts – ready to forgive, reconcile, and be renewed.

May we seek reconciliation and unity in all our relationships, knowing that God’s grace empowers us to be instruments of His peace,
