MASS INTENTIONS

There are infinite graces that flow from the Sacrifice of the Mass which benefits one's soul. The special ministerial fruits of the Mass are applied to the particular intention of the Mass. We have MANY open dates and times! The tradition of offering Masses for others, particularly the dead, originated in the very early Church. We have Mass Cards available in the office you can give to the family of a deceased person or Special Intention Cards for living, for a special occasion or for healing.



Pondering With Deacon George:

“This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him.”

On this Second Sunday of Lent, we are invited to a deeper encounter with God, echoing themes of listening, trust and transformation. The Gospel passage for this Sunday is the Transfiguration of Jesus, where Peter, James, and John witness Christ’s divinity shining through his humanity on a mountaintop. As we journey through Lent, this event stands as a beacon, calling us to see beyond the ordinary and recognize God’s presence in our daily lives.

On the mountain, the disciples hear the voice from the cloud: **“This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him.”** This command is the heart of our Lenten journey; a time to quiet the inner noise of our lives, silence the distractions, and listen anew to the words and ways of Jesus. Whether through prayer, scripture, or reflection, God urges us to pay attention and allow Christ’s message to reshape our hearts.

The Transfiguration is both awe-inspiring and unsettling for the disciples. They are confronted with a vision that stretches their understanding. Yet, Jesus reassures them: **“Rise, and do not be afraid.”** In our own lives, moments of challenge or uncertainty can feel overwhelming. Lent encourages us to trust God’s presence, even when the path is unclear. Just as the disciples are invited to descend the mountain and continue, we too are called to move forward with faith by:

Pausing and listening: Set aside moments this week to listen for God’s voice – through prayer, nature, or scripture.

Embracing trust: In moments of fear or uncertainty, recall Jesus’ words “Do not be afraid” and invite God’s calm.

Seeking transformation: Consider one area in our life where we need renewal. Offer it to God and ask for guidance.

The Second Sunday of Lent calls us to ascend with Jesus, to listen deeply, and to embrace transformation. May we trust in God’s loving presence as we journey together, preparing our hearts for Easter’s promise of new life,
