We have Mass Cards available in the office you can give to the family of a deceased person or Special Intention Cards for living, for a special occasion or for healing.



Pondering With Deacon George:

“I am the resurrection and the life.”

The Fifth Sunday of Lent draws us into the heart of God’s promise: **life where there was death, hope where there was despair.**

In the first reading, the prophet Ezekiel speaks to a people in exile, a nation that feels like a valley of dry bones. God’s word comes with power: **“I will open your graves and bring you back to the land of Israel.”** This is not only a promise of physical restoration but a pledge of spiritual renewal. God’s Spirit can breathe life into what seems beyond saving.

St. Paul, in the second reading, reminds the Romans—and us—that the Spirit who raised Jesus from the dead dwells within us. This indwelling Spirit is not a distant force but a living presence that transforms our mortal lives, making us participants in Christ’s victory over sin and death.

The Gospel brings this promise to its most personal and dramatic moment: the raising of Lazarus. Jesus does not rush to prevent Lazarus’s death; instead, He enters into the grief of Mary and Martha, weeping with them. Then, with divine authority, He calls Lazarus out of the tomb. This miracle is not only a sign of Jesus’ power but a revelation of His identity: **“I am the resurrection and the life.”**

As we approach Holy Week, this Sunday invites us to trust that no situation is beyond God’s reach. Our “graves” may be fear, sin, broken relationships, or spiritual dryness. Yet Christ stands before them, calling us to come forth. Lent is the time to let His voice reach us, to allow His Spirit to breathe new life into our weary hearts.

This week we can bring two questions to our prayer: Where in my life do I need to hear Jesus say, **“Come out”**? Am I willing to let Him unbind me from what keeps me from living fully in His love?

May God continue to guide us on our Lenten journey as we grow ever closer to celebrating the joys of Easter,
