Pondering With Deacon George:

“Hosanna to the Son of David!”

“Crucify Him, Crucify Him!”

Palm Sunday marks the beginning of Holy Week, a sacred time when we journey with Jesus through his final days in Jerusalem. We hear the story of Christ’s triumphant entry into the city, greeted by crowds waving palm branches and shouting, “Hosanna to the Son of David!” This moment is filled with hope and excitement, yet it quickly turns sobering as the passion narrative unfolds, reminding us that Jesus’ kingship is defined not by worldly power, but by humility, service, and sacrificial love. As we reflect on these events, we are invited to consider the contrast between the joy of Palm Sunday and the sorrow of the Passion. The same voices that welcomed Jesus with praise would soon cry out “Crucify Him! Crucify Him!” This challenges us to remain steadfast in our faith, especially in times of difficulty or disappointment. Palm Sunday encourages us to welcome Christ into our own lives with genuine hearts and to follow his example of forgiveness, compassion, and self-giving love throughout the week ahead.

This day marks a turning point in Lent, as we move from penance to a more intense meditation on Christ’s passion. We are invited to consider how our own struggles can be united with His, finding hope even amid pain.

May Passion Sunday inspire us to follow Christ with greater courage and compassion, trusting that through His sacrifice, we are led to new life,
