

## PARISH UPDATE

This past year we received a Safety Grant from the Archdiocese to implement a Key Card System on the entrance to the church and gym to enhance security. The key card system will allow us to control and monitor access to the buildings, ensuring only authorized individuals can enter designated areas at specific times.

The system has already been installed on the gym and church doors. Key Cards will be issued to those who need regular access to these buildings.

## *Pondering With Deacon George:*

**“Whoever drinks the water I shall give will never thirst. . .”**

Our Gospel this weekend presents us with the powerful story of Jesus and the Samaritan woman at the well; and is for us, both an invitation and a challenge – a call to recognize our deepest thirst and to embrace the living water that Christ offers each one of us.

The encounter between Jesus and the Samaritan woman is remarkable on many levels. Jesus, a Jewish man, breaks social and religious norms by speaking to a Samaritan and a woman – barriers that were not easily crossed in His time. He approaches her with compassion rather than judgment, opening a sincere conversation about her life and her spiritual longing.

In their dialogue, Jesus gently reveals her need for something deeper than physical water, acknowledging her past and present wounds without condemnation. This moment of profound honesty paves the way for transformation – not only for the woman but ultimately for her entire community, which she leads to Christ.

Jesus says, **“Whoever drinks the water I shall give will never thirst; the water I shall give will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life.”** This living water is a symbol of the Holy Spirit and the life of grace that Jesus offers. It quenches our spiritual thirst, filling the voids that worldly pursuits cannot satisfy.

Lent is a time for us to recognize our own thirsts – our desires for meaning, forgiveness, and authentic love. Like the woman at the well, we may come to Jesus burdened by sins or disappointments. Yet, He offers us acceptance and renewal, reaching across every barrier to invite us into a deeper relationship.

Transformed by her encounter with Jesus, the Samaritan woman becomes a witness, inviting others to “come and see”. When we experience God’s mercy and grace, we are called to share that joy and hope with others.

May we, like the woman at the well, become bearers of the Good News, inviting all to encounter Christ, the source of living water,
