Peace Be With You!

This weekend, the Second Sunday of Easter is also known as Divine Mercy Sunday. It is a day to remember that God's mercy is for all people. The readings tell us about faith, hope, and the joy that comes from meeting the Risen Lord. They also remind us that believing in Him brings peace and new life.

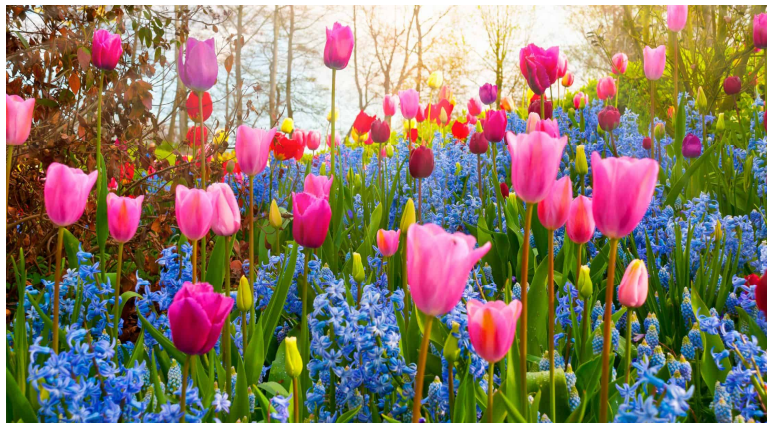
In the first reading, we hear about the early Christians. They lived together, shared what they had, and cared for those in need. Their lives were filled with prayer, worship, and love for one another. This shows how faith can change the way we live each day.

The Gospel tells the story of Thomas. At first, he doubted the other disciples. When he saw Jesus, he believed. Jesus said that those who believe without seeing are blessed. The Second Sunday of Easter each year invites us to trust Him even when we do not have all the answers.

As followers of the resurrected Lord, we are called to trust Jesus and to live lives of mercy. During the Easter season, we can look for small acts of mercy that we can do to bring the peace of Jesus to others. We can extend forgiveness to those who have wronged us, even when it feels underserved. We can show patience and understanding toward others, especially when they are facing difficulties. We can show kindness in everyday interactions, a smile, a compliment, a helping hand can go a long way. These actions may seem small, but they reflect the heart of Jesus.

As we move through the Easter Season, let's remember that Jesus comes to us with peace. He understands fear. He meets doubt with patience. He offers mercy over and over again. Trust does not mean having all the answers. It means choosing to open the door when Jesus knocks. Like the disciples, we need to let Him step into our life and slowly change how we live and love.
