## *Pondering With Deacon George:*

**“Were not our hearts burning within us  
while he talked to us on the road?”**

The Third Sunday of Easter invites us to encounter the risen Christ in the ordinary moments of our lives. Today’s Gospel tells the story of two disciples on the road to Emmaus, whose hearts were heavy with grief and confusion until Jesus himself drew near, though they did not recognize him at first. As he walked with them, opened the Scriptures, and finally broke bread, their eyes were opened and they recognized the Lord.

This passage reminds us that Jesus often comes to us in unexpected ways and at times when we least anticipate his presence. Like the disciples, we may carry burdens or disappointments that cloud our sight, yet Christ journeys with us, offering hope and understanding. When we open our hearts to his word and share in the Eucharist, we too can experience the warmth and joy that moved the disciples to proclaim, “Were not our hearts burning within us while he talked to us on the road?”

On our daily journey, Jesus comes to us in small ways—a kind word from a friend, a moment of peace during prayer, a song at Mass that touches our heart, or even a Bible verse that feels like it’s speaking directly to us. At first, we might not realize that these moments are from Him. But when we look back, we can often see that Jesus was working in our life all along.

There are times on our journey of life when we are struggling, and someone reached out to help us. Maybe they encouraged us, prayed for us, or simply listened. Those moments could have been Jesus reaching out to us through another person.

As we continue through the Easter season, let us be attentive to Christ’s presence in our daily lives—through scripture, in the breaking of bread, and in one another.

May our hearts be transformed by his love, and may we, like the disciples, go forth to share the good news of the Resurrection with all we meet,
