Pondering With Deacon George:

“I am the good shepherd... I know my sheep, and mine know me. I have come so that they may have life and have it to the full.”

The Fourth Sunday of Easter, often known as Good Shepherd Sunday, invites us to reflect deeply on the comforting image of Jesus as our shepherd. In our Gospel this weekend Jesus describes himself as the gate for the sheep, declaring, “Whoever enters through me will be saved, and will come in and go out and find pasture.” This metaphor speaks powerfully of care, guidance, and protection. Jesus is not a distant overseer but one who knows each sheep by name and lays down his life for them. Jesus, as the gate for the sheep, is the one through whom we enter into safety, nourishment, and abundant life. His voice is the one that calls us out of confusion, fear, and isolation into a place of belonging. The Good Shepherd does not lead from behind with force, but walks ahead, guiding with love and trust. In a world that can often feel uncertain or even perilous, these words assure us that we are not alone or forgotten.

Today, we are called to listen for the voice of the Good Shepherd, to recognize it amid the many competing voices and distractions in our lives. Following Christ’s voice leads us to true freedom and abundant life, not just a life of comfort, but one filled with purpose and meaning. As we continue our journey through Easter, may we trust in Jesus’ guidance, allow ourselves to be led by his gentle care, and strive to reflect his compassion in our relationships with others. Let us remember that the Good Shepherd walks with us always, offering hope, healing, and peace.

May we follow the Good Shepherd closely, trust His leading, and reflect His care to a world longing for safety and belonging,

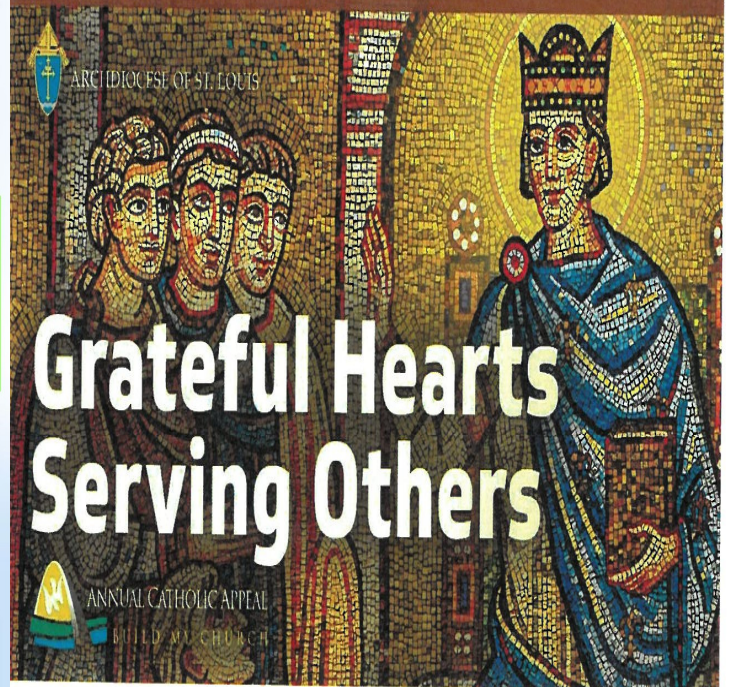
