**Christ Is Risen, Alleluia!

Most happy and blessed Easter! Today is the glorious culmination of our journey through Lent and Holy Week. On this Easter Sunday, we celebrate the greatest feast of our Christian faith: the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. 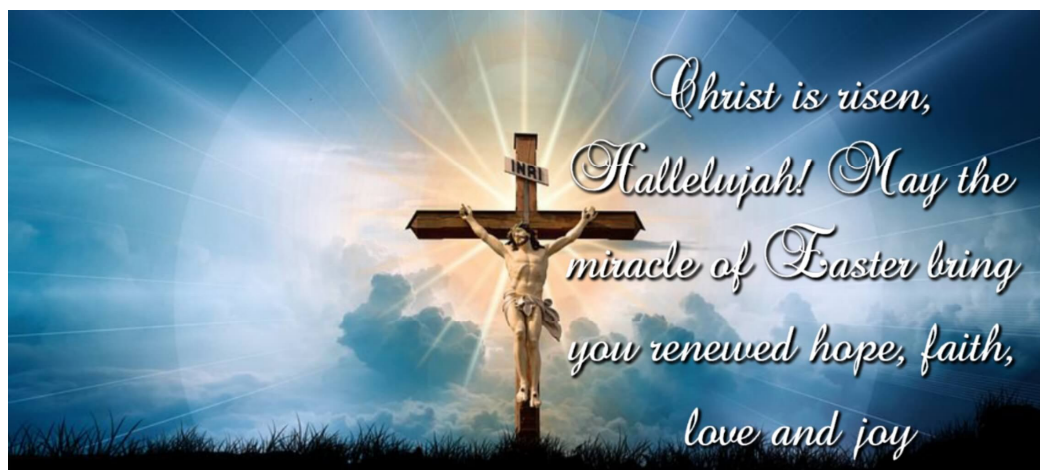
