## *Pondering With Deacon George:*

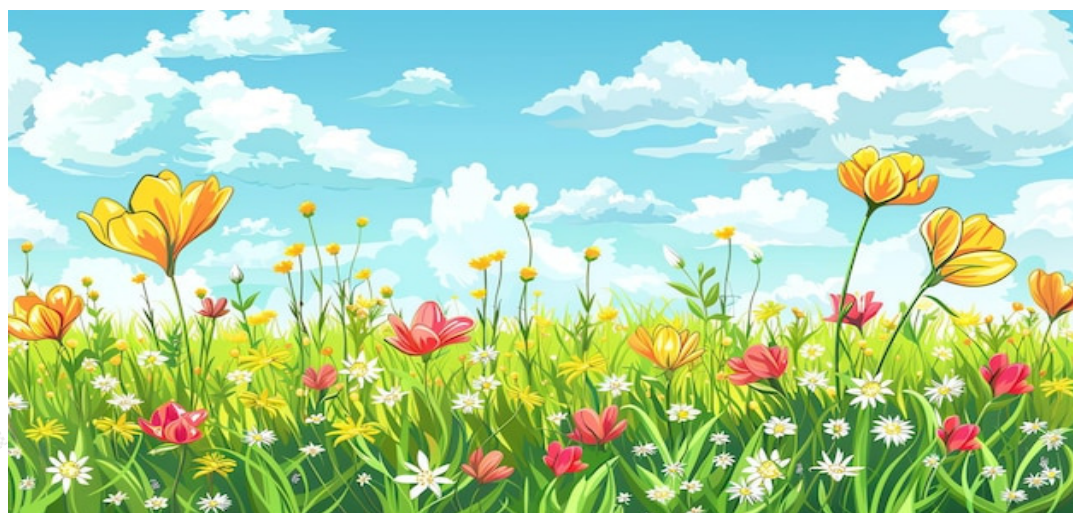
**I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you.  
John 14:18**

Blessed Sixth Week of Easter. This weekend we are invited to reflect deeply on the promise of new life and the ongoing presence of Christ in our daily journey. As the disciples navigated uncertainty and change, they were reassured that Jesus would not leave them orphaned but would send the Holy Spirit to guide, comfort, and empower them. This assurance remains relevant for us today, especially as we face our own moments of doubt and transition. It is in these moments that we can be assured of Jesus' promise, just as the disciples were, that those who love Him will be loved by the Father, and that He will come to them. This means that our relationship with God is not distant or cold. God wants to be close to us. When we pray, listen to His word, and take part in the life of the Church, we grow closer to Him.
