## *Pondering With Deacon George:*

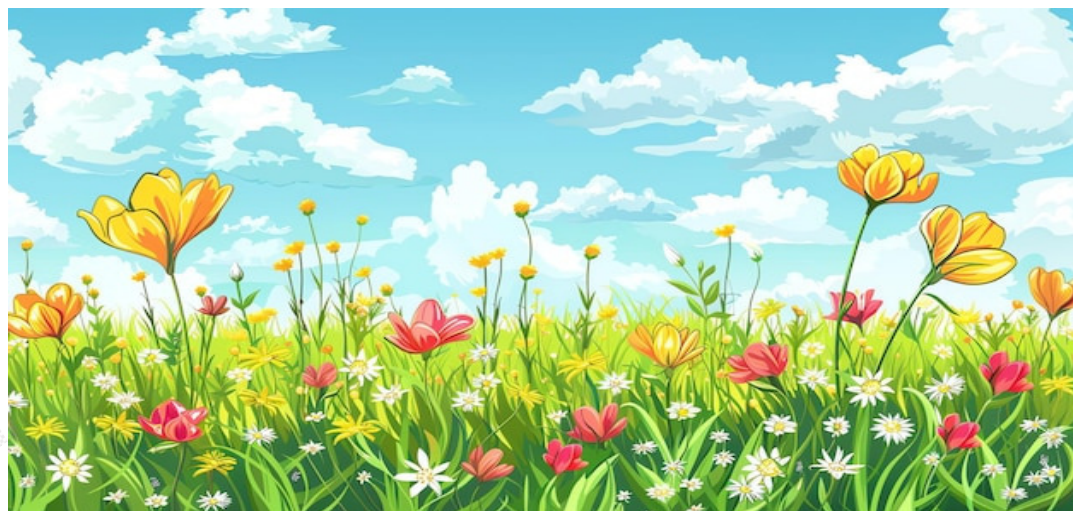
**“Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations,  
baptizing them in the name of the Father,  
and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit,  
teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you.  
And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age.”**

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord, marking the completion of Jesus’ earthly mission, His exaltation to divine glory, and His ongoing presence with believers through the Holy Spirit. As we recall Jesus’ ascending into heaven, we are reminded that His departure is not an abandonment, but a commissioning: He entrusts His disciples – and us – with the task of continuing His work in the world. The promise of the Holy Spirit assures us that we are not alone; Christ remains with us through His Spirit, empowering us to bear witness to His love and truth.

On this feast we do not just recall an event that took place 2,000 years ago, but embrace the mission he gave his apostles, Christians through the centuries and to us as well, to be messengers of hope and faith. As Jesus tells His followers to go forth and make disciples of all nations, we too are challenged to share the Gospel in our communities and daily lives. The Ascension reminds us that our journey of faith does not end with Christ’s departure but begins anew with His invitation to carry His presence into the world. May we embrace this mission, trusting in the guidance and strength of the Holy Spirit, and look forward with joy to the day when we will be united with Christ in His glory.

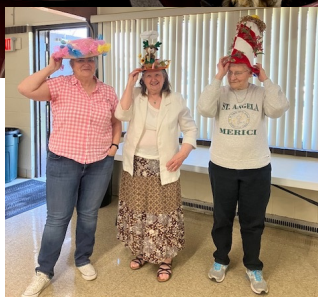
### HOSPICE VOLUNTEERS NEEDED
