

## *Pondering With Deacon George:*

**I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.**

**John 14:6**

When Jesus spoke these words to his disciples at the Last Supper, he was preparing his disciples for what was to come. He knew he would soon suffer and die, and he wanted them to understand that he was the only path to God the Father. By calling himself “the way,” Jesus was saying that he is the one who leads us to God. We do not have to be lost or confused about how to get to heaven – Jesus shows us the way through his teachings and his example.

When Jesus said he is “the truth,” he was reminding us that everything he says is trustworthy. In a world where people have different opinions and beliefs, it can be hard to know what is right. But Jesus is the truth that never changes. His words and actions reveal who God is and what God wants for us. When we follow Jesus, we follow what is real and lasting.

Jesus also said he is “the life.” This means that through him, we receive true life – not just here on earth, but eternal life with God. Many things in the world promise happiness, but only Jesus gives us the kind of life that satisfies our hearts. When we stay close to him, we experience real joy and peace.

Sometimes life feels uncertain. We may have doubts, struggles, or fears. Jesus’ words in this passage remind us that we do not have to figure everything out on our own. He is the way, the truth, and the life, which means we can trust him completely. He does not just point us in the right direction – he walks with us. He does not just tell us the truth – he is the truth. And he does not just give us life – he is our life. When we trust Jesus, we don’t have to be afraid. Even when things are hard, we can have confidence that he is leading us. He promises to prepare a place for us in heaven, which means that no matter what happens in this life, we have something greater waiting for us. This can give us peace and hope, even when we don’t understand everything right now.

Let us remember that Jesus is always with us. He is not just a historical figure or a distant God – he is here, guiding us every day. May we follow him, believe his words, and stay close to him, in this we will find true joy and purpose,
