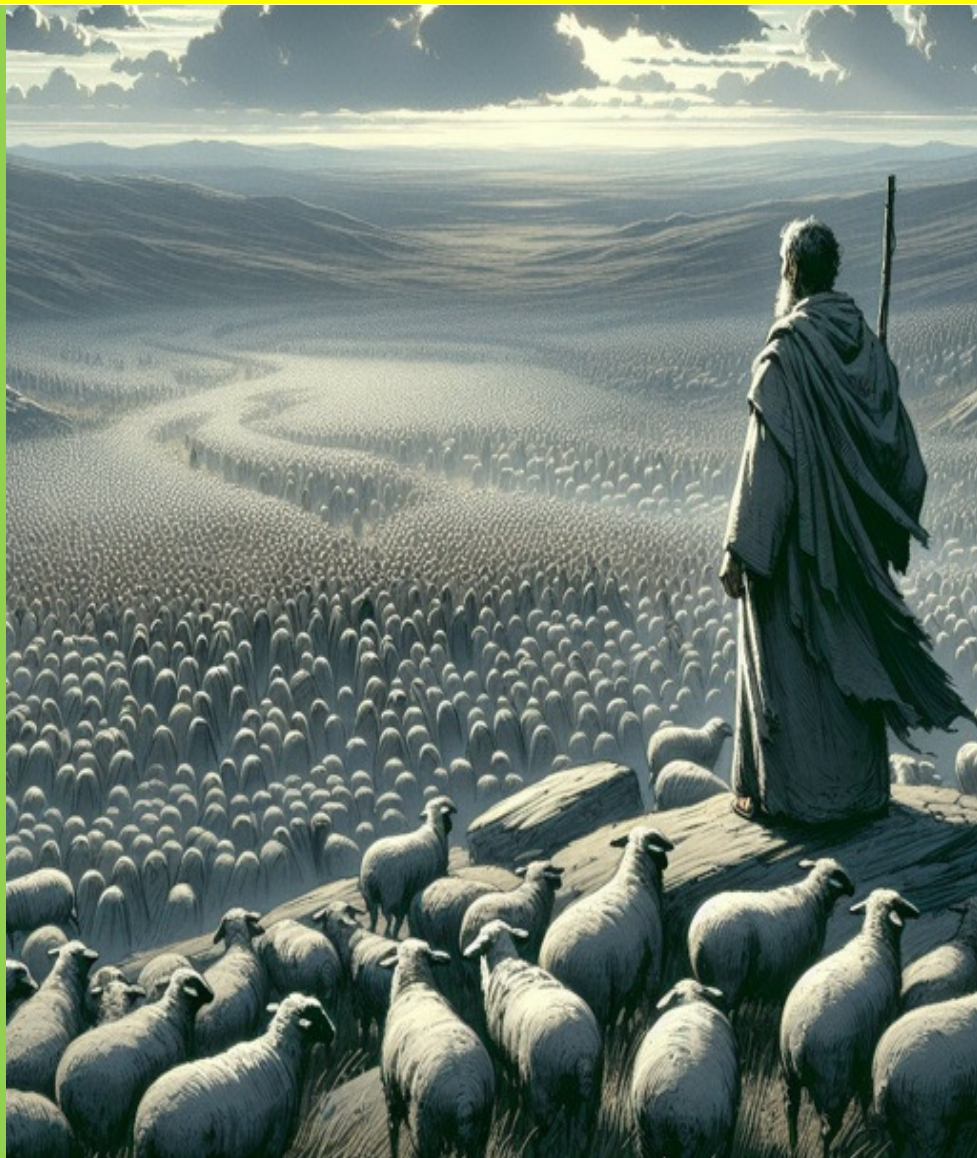

Pondering With Deacon George:

Called and Sent in Love

The readings on this 11th Sunday in Ordinary Time, center on a God who first loves, first chooses, and first sends. In Exodus, the Lord reminds Israel that He carried them “on eagle wings” and made them His own people. In Saint Paul’s letter to the Romans, we hear the heart of the Gospel: Christ died for us not because we had earned it, but while we were still weak and sinful. In the Gospel, Jesus looks upon the crowd with deep compassion, seeing people who are weary, troubled, and searching for direction. Before He sends the disciples, He first sees the pain of the people. Mission begins in mercy and flows from love.

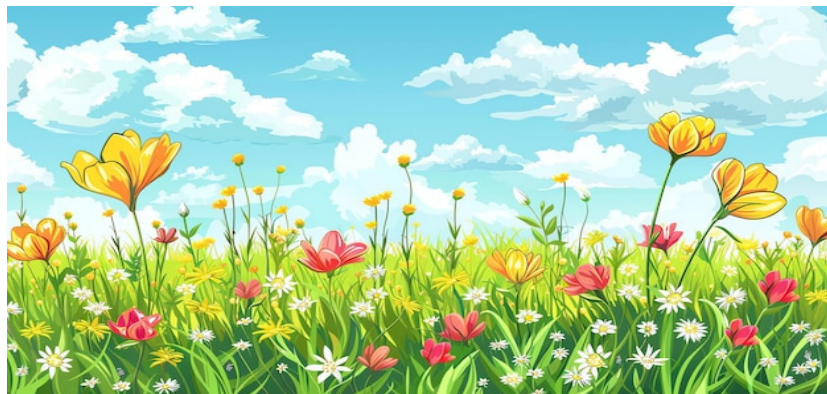
This Sunday invites us to remember that our Christian calling is not based on perfection, but on grace. God does not wait for us to become flawless before He loves us. He meets us in our weakness, heals us, and then entrusts us with His work. The words of Jesus, “The harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few,” are not only about priests, deacons, religious, or missionaries. They are also addressed to every believer who is called to bring hope, kindness, truth, and healing into the places where people feel abandoned or lost. The disciple is one who has first received mercy and then becomes a bearer of mercy.

Perhaps the most important question this Sunday asks us is this: when we look at others, do we see them with the eyes of Christ? It is easy to judge, ignore, or grow indifferent. But Jesus teaches us to see with compassion and to respond with generosity. We have received so much without cost – life, faith, forgiveness, and love. Therefore, we are sent to give without counting the cost.

When we receive the Eucharist, we are renewed in courage to serve, humility to trust, and the compassion to become workers in the Lord’s harvest.

May the Eucharist conform us more into the image of Christ Jesus,
