Pondering With Deacon George:

**So do not be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows.”
Matthew 10:31**

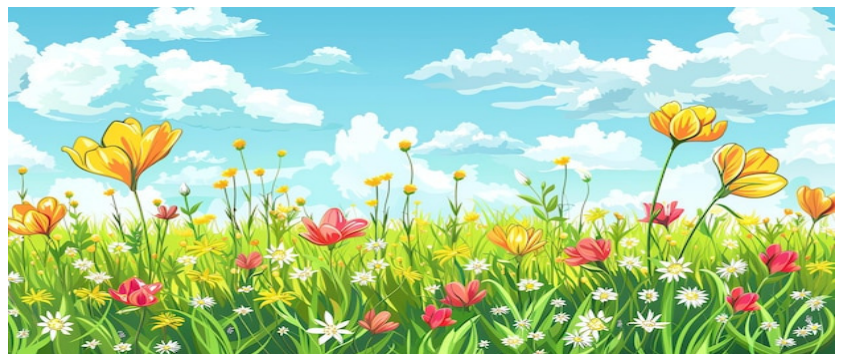
The readings for this Sunday speak directly to the fears that live in every human heart. Jeremiah knows rejection, hostility, and loneliness, yet he still proclaims with confidence that the Lord is with him like a mighty champion. In the Gospel, Jesus repeats the words we most need to hear: do not be afraid. He does not deny that suffering, misunderstanding, or opposition will come, but he reminds us that none of these has the final word. God sees, God knows, and God remains near.

Saint Paul deepens this hope by showing the contrast between Adam and Christ. Sin entered the world through one man, but grace overflows through Jesus Christ. Fear often grows when we focus only on weakness, failure, or the brokenness around us. But the Christian life is not built on defeat; it is built on grace. In Christ, we are not trapped by the power of sin or the discouragement of the world. We are given new life, new strength, and the courage to stand in truth.

This Gospel invites us to examine what keeps us silent. Sometimes we are afraid of judgment, afraid of losing approval, or afraid of being different. Yet Jesus tells us that even the sparrows are known by the Father, and we are worth far more than many sparrows. To follow Christ is to live with quiet courage: to speak truth with love, to remain faithful when it is unpopular, and to trust that our lives are held in God's hands. When we acknowledge Christ before others, we witness not only with our words but with the steady faithfulness of our lives.

Lord Jesus, in moments of fear and uncertainty, teach me to trust in your care. Give me courage to witness to you with honesty, humility, and love. Help me remember that I am known, loved, and held by the Father. May your grace be stronger than my fear, and may my life proclaim your truth each day. Amen.
