Pondering With Deacon George:

Today the Church celebrates the great gift of the
Body and Blood of Christ.
Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

This feast invites us to pause in wonder before the mystery of the Eucharist – not simply as a symbol, but as the real presence of Jesus given for the life of the world. In this weekend’s gospel, Jesus says: **“Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day.”** These words can sound difficult, even shocking, but they reveal something deeply comforting: God does not remain distant from us. In Jesus, God comes close – so close that He becomes our food and drink.

The Eucharist is the sign of a love that holds nothing back. Jesus gives not merely something He has, but His very self. Every time we receive Holy Communion, we are reminded that we are not alone, not abandoned, and not left to find our way by ourselves. Christ nourishes us with His presence, strengthens us in weakness, and draws us into communion with Him and with one another.

This feast also challenges us. If we receive the Body of Christ, then we are called to become the Body of Christ in the world. The Eucharist is never only personal devotion; it is also a mission. We are sent forth to live what we celebrate – to become bread broken for others, to be agents of compassion, justice, forgiveness, and peace.

The feast of Corpus Christi asks us to reflect:

- Do I approach the Eucharist with faith and gratitude?
- Do I recognize Christ’s presence not only at the altar, but also in the people around me?

Am I allowing this sacred gift to transform the way I live?

The Eucharist is heaven’s food for the journey of earth. In a world often marked by division, loneliness, and hunger of many kinds, Christ offers Himself as the true bread that satisfies the deepest needs of the human heart.

May this feast renew in us a profound love for the Eucharist. May we receive Jesus with reverence, adore Him with gratitude, and carry Him into the world with joy,
